

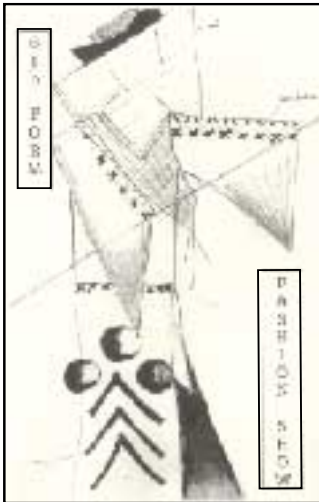


# Art Report
