



Gymnastics 2003/4



Port Regis School hosted the IAPS Gymnastics Championships in November. Vinehall entered three teams. In the U10 age group Lily Canetty-Clarke came 2nd for her set floor exercise and 23rd overall on all four disciplines; this was out of 75 gymnasts. Stephanie Colvin also did well on set floor scoring 9.2. The other members of the U10 team Jenny Bolden, Eliza Elliott and Patricia Harriman all performed well and gained valuable experience from their first national competition.

The U11 team came 7th for their group sequence and 6th in the team competition. Marie Cotton-Rhein came 6th for her set floor routine and was 17th overall in the individual competition. Phoebe Ashenheim, Savannah Lawson, Beetle Gage and Sophie Oulton all performed well despite very stiff competition from the other schools.

In the U13 age group Catriona Flint did exceptionally well to come 4th on set vault and 7th overall in the individual competition. On voluntary floor Sarah Williamson was 12th and Sophie Wakeham 9th. On set floor Georgie Beattie came 9th and Sophie Pugh was 3rd with a super score of 9.35. The team came 5th for their group sequence and 4th in the team event missing a medal by just a few points. Genevieve Pugh was reserve for the team and was a great support to all the gymnasts.



In March we travelled to Brussels for the GISGA Championships. This was an exciting weekend of competition and we even managed to fit in some sightseeing. As always the standard of gymnastics was high with some very exciting routines and the tumbling was outstanding with some very diverse styles of presentation.

Sarah Williamson had the top score for Vinehall on voluntary floor. Catriona Flint also had a good competition she came 6th on set floor, 4th on set vault and 20th overall.
