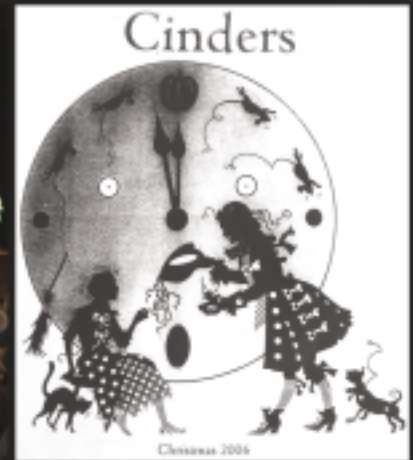


Drama
