Two key features in our school calendar are the mathematics challenges in November and April. The Primary Mathematics Challenge in November for Years 5 and 6 was taken by more than 99,000 pupils. Teachers in more than 2,694 schools entered pupils for the Challenge and The Mathematics Association posted nearly 69,000 certificates for presentation in assemblies! At Vinehall, we were delighted to award 6 Gold, 9 Silver and 11 Bronze certificates.

On return from the Easter vacation, our top set in Years 8, 7 and 6, plus a number of strong CE candidates, took the UK Junior Mathematical Challenge. We are always pleased when our Year 6 pupils achieve a certificate but this year for the first time we offered three of our promising Year 5s the opportunity of grappling with some testing problems and to our delight they all scored sufficient points to earn a bronze certificate!



More than 240,000 pupils across the country participated in this event and we were delighted to award 10 Gold, 10 Silver and 17 Bronze awards. Well done to all the successful pupils! As well as achieving her Gold award and **Best in School, Philippa Moore** qualified for the Junior Olympiad on 16th June, a two-hour paper of more in-depth mathematical problems.
