

# PSHE

The Records of Achievement (ROA) are now well established in Years 6, 7 and 8. This year has seen the completion of the information moving from PSHE lessons (after the initial training in Year 6) to form time being directed by the form tutor. The Records are now being used to help the form teachers monitor the pupils' activities and successes. The compilation of the individual shields for Year 8 pupils has proved much more straightforward now that the pupils' recording of information for the shields is a continuous process

PSHE lessons continue to give children the opportunity to discuss whole school issues such as for School Council (see below). Pupils have discussed anti-bullying measures and friendships, considered the nature of responsibility, leadership and government, and in the Summer term, Year 7 pupils were again guided to apply for the role of prefect. There has been an increased emphasis on internet safety this year for Year 6, 7 and 8 to tackle the growing areas of concern for young people of cyber-bullying and safe-guarding personal information to prevent exploitation.
