

START OF MICHAELMAS TERM CHECK LIST

All labelling should be in permanent marker and not stick on labels which peel off very quickly. Scratching on initials and numbers works well on all plastic items, including pens. Children should avoid bringing any toy or item to school which has any value – either financial or emotional. If children are allowed to bring a toy on a trip, for example, then it should be clearly labelled and locked in their locker while not in use. All clothing must be labelled – including underwear!

GIRLS	Notes	Done
Shoes	To be of black leather which can be polished to shine. School number clearly visible inside. Pumps style shoes are NOT allowed. Shoes should have a distinct small heel. Fashion shoes (e.g. ornate diamante buckles etc) are not allowed.	
Tights	Tights must be blue and not black	
White shirts	All Year 8 wear white shirts every day.	
Hair cuts	Out of eyes. No colouring or extremes of style. Hair over the collar should be tied back at all times. Head bands and accessories should be in blue or black.	
Stationery (H pencils (not HB), pen, cartridges, rubber, sharpener, pencil crayons (set of at least 6), ruler.	All items numbered/named	
Maths Stationery (Year 5+ protractor, compasses and Year 6+ set squares)	All items numbered/named	
Calculator (Year 6+)	These are ordered through school. Numbered/named	
Head lice	Check ten days before start of term and then again at four days. You may be asked to withdraw your child if he is found to be infested.	
Games clothing	As per clothing list. All named and looped.	
Play track suit	As per clothing list. All named and looped.	
Wellingtons	All children should have a pair. Labelled/numbered clearly at top.	
Trainers	Labelled preferably on the heel.	
Watches (Year 6+)	Initials/number scratched or engraved on reverse.	
Mobiles	Full boarders only. Initialled and kept upstairs by matron. Internet access must be disabled.	
Book bags	School design and house colour and clearly named. Obtainable from school shop.	
Coats	As per clothing list. Year 3-6 Looped and names	
Blue school cagoule (Year 7 and 8 instead of coat to be worn over blazer)	Looped and named. Available in school shop.	

Toys etc	For boarders only. Named and kept upstairs. Ipods for boarders must be checked for unsuitable content.	
Netballs etc	Named and kept in a string bag or carrier bag on peg.	
Jewellery	Jewellery is not permitted. Where a girl has pierced ears then a very small pair of plain silver or gold studs should be used. Discreet religious items may be worn. If in doubt please ask. For information, all jewellery has to be removed or taped for games.	
Medical matters	Update Sister Victoria with any changes.
