



Mixed Generation Tennis and Golf

The Vinehall School Mixed Generation Tennis and Golf Competition will take place on Sunday 4th October. There will be morning and afternoon start times so that you will be able to play in both sports if you wish.

In both sports children must play with an adult of a different generation (not an older sibling). In tennis, the adult must also be the opposite sex (i.e. girls with an adult male, boys with an adult female). The golf is a foursomes stableford and adults are restricted to three clubs (no woods). The tennis will be five games against each other pair in your group.

The format of the day will be as follows:

12.30 Lunch (provided, see below)	
1.30 Afternoon School Bell Start	1.30 Afternoon round
Approx 3.30 pm finish

Trophies will be awarded at the end of the day.
