This means by their honesty and integrity, their personal loyalty to the Head, by their attitude to work, their personal self-discipline, their willingness to bear responsibility and their constant courtesy about the school.

It is required of school prefects that they should know the rules and customs of school life; that they themselves should obey them and that they should see that other pupils obey them too.

The principle by which school prefects should be guided in the conduct of their lives and in the performance of their duties is the concept of service: to serve the pupils, staff and the whole community of which they are a part.
