

# Sports Day 2008

We have tried to ensure that everyone takes part in at least 2 events on the programme. In fact, the majority of children are involved in at least 3 events today. The purpose of the open events is to include more children in Sports Day. Team selection for each member of the House is restricted to 2 track and 1 field event, or 2 field and 1 track event. The relays do not count in this allocation. The 1500m and High Jump events have been held before Sports Day and the results will count towards the Victor/Victrix Ludorum. There are some open events which do not count towards the VL individual scores: these are included in the programme to give more events to boys and girls who have already taken part in a pre-Sports Day event.

## **Open Events on Pitch 2:**

All children are encouraged to take part in these events during the day. There are 5 standards for performance for each event and children can improve the points aggregate for their House by having a go.

All Open Events are divided into Junior, Middle, Senior competitions.

Points for each competition: 1<sup>st</sup> (8) 2<sup>nd</sup> (6) 3<sup>rd</sup> (4) 4<sup>th</sup> (2)

A final reminder that all boys and girls must listen carefully for the announcement of their event to avoid the disappointment of missing a race.
