#### RED WINES

##### Hardy's Nottage Hill Shiraz

*Aromas of spicy black pepper, ripe blackberry fruit and subtle nuances of toasted oak.* **£10.00**

##### Chateau Barreyres Haut-Medoc Cru Bourgeois

*Pretty plum and berry aromas with hints of tobacco and smoke lead to a full wine with loads of chocolate and berry character, and good lingering aftertaste.* **£15.00**

##### Crozes-Hermitage 'Les Pierelles' Domaine Belle Pere et Fils

*Typically northern Rhone Syrah with lots of dark savoury fruit flavours and hints of drying spices. There are some very elegant grape and oak tannins.* **£20.00**

#### WHITE WINES

##### Montana Sauvignon Blanc

*Distinctive ripe green pepper aromas follow on to fresh gooseberry fruit flavours on the palate. Well balanced and crisp.* **£10.00**

##### Pinot Gris Baron de Hoen 2005

*An opulent white. Fat and almost oily, with nut and peach flavours, yet with a fresh finish and enough acidity to keep it balanced.* **£15.00**

##### Chablis Premier Cru Beauroy Alain Geoffroy 2004

*Tasty, offering honey, almond, apple and mineral aromas and flavours integrated with a supple texture and supported by lively acidity.* **£20.00**

#### ROSE WINES

##### Sancerre Rose Eric Louis 2005

*A delightful salmon pink rose, with a bright and powerful nose, displaying a balanced combination of dryness, elegance, softness and subtlety all at the same time.* **£15.00**
